



### **Oral Nicotine Pouches**

According to a recent survey, 22% of Montanans aged 15-25 reported having tried oral nicotine pouches, such as Zyn, Velo or On!, which come in youth-friendly flavors like mango and citrus.

While many nicotine pouches claim to be tobacco-free, these products contain

nicotine derived from tobacco. Youth use of *any* form of nicotine is unsafe due to its harmful effects on the developing brain.

My Life, My Quit provides confidential coaching via text, chat, or phone for Montanans under the age of 18 who need help quitting all forms of commercial tobacco use, including nicotine pouches.
