E-CIGARETTE ADDICTION ON THE RISE

THE PREVALENCE OF YOUNG ADULT (AGES 18 TO 24) E-CIGARETTE USE HAS MORE THAN DOUBLED SINCE 2017 AND IS NOW NEARLY FOUR TIMES HIGHER THAN THAT OF ADULTS AGES 25 AND OLDER. THE INCREASE IN YOUNG ADULT E-CIGARETTE USE IS LIKELY DUE TO THE AGING OF THOSE WHO BECAME ADDICTED TO THE PRODUCT IN THEIR TEENS. FREQUENT AND DAILY E-CIGARETTE USE AMONG MONTANA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS INCREASED BY ALMOST 200% FROM 2015 TO 2023, ACCORDING TO THE MONTANA YOUTH RISK BEHAVIOR SURVEY.
